

## How can I be safe online?

In this unit of work, the children will learn about internet safety and what to do if they experience any problems. They will be taught how to log on and off a computer safely. Children will use Microsoft word to become more familiar with a keyboard.

### In this unit children will:

- Identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content or contact on the internet or other online technologies.
- Develop knowledge of internet safety.
- Read the e-safety story about Smartie the penguin.
- Learn how to log and off a computer correctly.
- Be able to open word document and type using the keyboard.
- Children will be shown how to print off their work on word document.

### Key Knowledge

- User names and passwords will be given to the children to enable them to log onto their computer as Year 1 pupils.

### Key Vocabulary

**Computer** - an electronic device for storing and processing data.

**Screen** - a screen used to display the output of a computer to the user.

**Tower** - contain all the components your PC needs to function.

**Keyboard** - a panel of keys that operate a computer.

**Username** - an identification used by a person with access to a computer, network, or online service.

**Password** – a secret word or phrase that allows access to a computer system or service.

**Internet** - a network of computers linked all over the world.
