

Why should we talk about internet safety?

At Hedon Primary School we pride ourselves in education the children well in using the internet safely. The children get to use different electronic devices in different ways and in this unit have the chance to discuss internet safety with the class.

In this unit children will:

- This topic and discussions will link with our IT topic where the children can put what they have learn into action.
- We will look at how to use the internet safely and using different devices to their full potential safely.
- We will look at what cyber bullying is and what to do if it is seen.
- They will have a look at how media can influence the way we live our lives eg. shopping.
- We will discuss the power of the internet including the use of other devices such as iPads and mobile phones.

Key Vocabulary

- **cyber bullying** – using electronic devices to bully others, such as sending horrible messages.
- **Notice**- Recognise if there has been a change in mood or behaviour and explore what the cause might be.
- **Talk** - Ask questions to learn what is happening, how it started, and who is involved.
- **Report** - Most social media platforms and schools have clear policies and reporting processes. If a classmate is cyberbullying, report it a teacher.
- **Support** - Peers, mentors, and trusted adults can sometimes intervene publicly to positively influence a situation where negative or hurtful content posts about a child.
