

Who am I?

In this unit of work the children will find out about their own development and changes since birth. They will learn about the past, present and future and what has happened during their small life so far.

They will also learn about their location in Hedon and significant historical events in their own locality.

In this unit children will:

- Look at their own **personal history**, what have they achieved in their life at different ages.
- Understand what the vocabulary; **past**, **present** and **future** means and be able to use this to describe their own life.
- Look into their **family tree** and understand how **family members** are linked.
- Develop knowledge of key **human features**, including: **city, town, village, factory, farm, house** and **shop**.
- Locate where we live on a map of England.
- Find our street on a map of **Hedon**.
- Understand why significant **historical events**, people and places in their own **locality**. Explore some of the past events of Hedon.
- Recognise **similarities** and **differences** between ways of life across history and how things have changed.

personal – belonging to that one person.

past – something that has already happened.

present – something that is happening right now.

future – something that is going to happen.

family tree – a drawing showing how people are related in a family.

family members – people in a family.

timeline – a representation of time showing different things that have, usually, already happened.

events – something that has happened in a life time.

United Kingdom- the UK, is officially known as the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. It includes England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.

town- a small group of houses, perhaps with a few shops, usually a built up area that is larger than a village.

Key Knowledge

- During the lifetime of every person, significant things happen and things change. Sometimes the things that change are personal to the person or can be worldwide changes.
- Sometimes things that have happened in the past can be celebrated years on.
- Sometimes things that are going to happen in the future are celebrated too.
- Every person has a family tree, sometimes this is big and sometimes this is small. They are all different – every family is different.
- We can draw a timeline to show when things have happened, this can include when people were born.
- Our school is in Hedon which is a small town in the United Kingdom. Hedon is usually too small to see on a map but you can find Hull.
- Hedon has changed a lot over time.
- St Augustines church in Hedon is very old and was started to be built 1190. The church is still here today.



- The United Kingdom is made up of four countries – England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales. We live in England.
- The United Kingdom flag is called the Union Jack.
