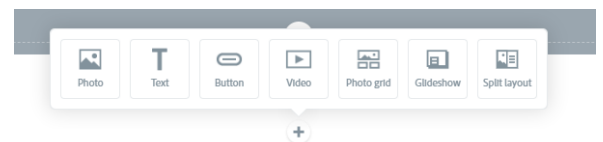

photogrid – a collect of photos

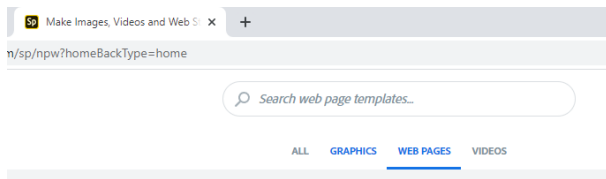
Glide show - gives you a beautiful way to tell your story. Choose photos, then add text, block quotes, images, and more.

Split screen – have more than one area on your screen.

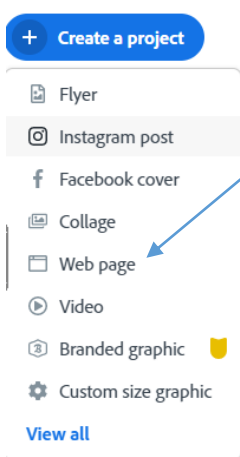

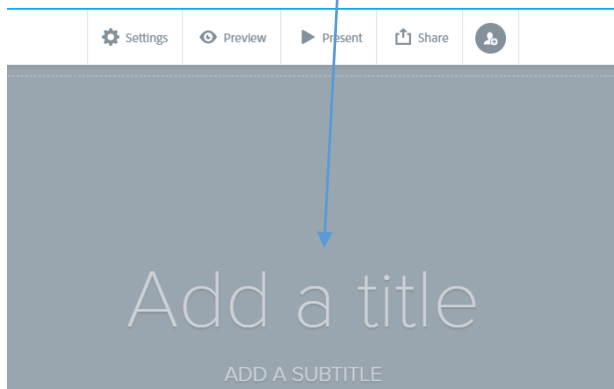

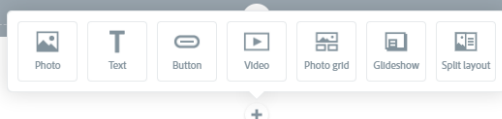


Adobe guides you through each step, just read the options.



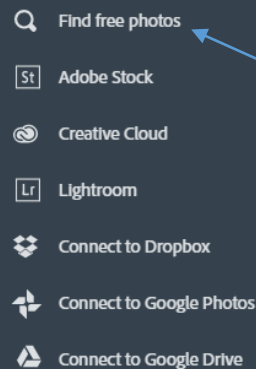
As you move down the web page, click on the +

Add photos

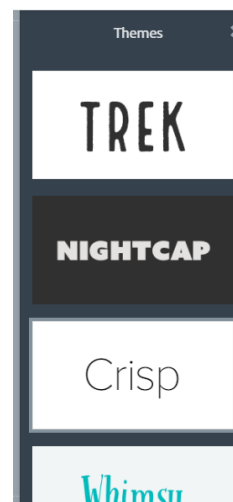
Upload photo
