

Year 4, Autumn 1, spellings.

We are having a massive push on spellings and being able to retain the spellings learnt. Here are the spellings for the full half term, which the children will be tested on and some will be tested from the previous weeks too. Please try and speak about the different spelling rules with your child so it is imbedded. The children will be having more discrete spelling lessons and using the words for handwriting sessions too.

<b>Week 1</b> These words are homophones. They have the same pronunciation but different spellings.	<b>Week 2</b> The prefix 'in' which can mean both 'not' and 'in/into'.	<b>Week 3</b> Before a root word starting with 'i' the 'in' prefix becomes a 'il'. Before a root word starting with 'r' the prefix 'in' becomes 'ir'.	<b>Week 4</b> The prefix 'sub' means below or under.	<b>Week 5</b> The prefix 'inter' means between, amongst and during.	<b>Week 6</b> These are challenge words – have a go!  These words are in the spelling words for year 3 and 4.
