

Year 3, Autumn 1, spellings.

We are having a massive push on spellings and being able to retain the spellings learnt. Here are the spellings for the full half term, which the children will be tested on and some will be tested from the previous weeks too. Please try and speak about the different spelling rules with your child so it is embedded. The children will be having more discrete spelling lessons and using the words for handwriting sessions too.

Week 2 The /ow/ sound spelled 'ou'. Found often in the middle of words, sometimes at the beginning and very rarely at the end of words.	Week 3 The /u/ sound spelled 'ou'. This digraph is only found in the middle of words.	Week 4 The /i/ sound spelt with a 'y'.	Week 5 Words with endings that sound like /ze/, as in measure, are always spelled with 'sure'.	Week 6 Words with endings that sound like /ch/ are often spelt 'ture' unless the root word ends in 'tch'.	Week 7 These are challenge words – have a go! These words are in the spelling words for year 3 and 4.
