Here are the spellings for the full half term, which the children will be tested on and some will be tested from the previous weeks too. Please try and speak about the different spelling rules with your child so it is embedded. The children will be having more discrete spelling lessons and using the words for handwriting sessions too.

<b>Week 1</b> The 'au' digraph.	<b>Week 2</b> The suffix 'ion' when the root word ends in 't' or 'te' then the suffix becomes 'tion'.	<b>Week 3</b> The suffix 'ion' becomes 'ssion' when the root word ends in 'ss' or 'mit'.	<b>Week 4</b> The suffix 'cian' used instead of 'sion' when the root word ends in 'c' or 'cs'.	<b>Week 5</b> Adding 'ly' to create adverbs of manner. These adverbs describe how the verb is occurring.	<b>Week 6</b> These are the challenge words - have a go!
